## RESIDENTIAL GUTTERS AND DOWNPIPES WARRANTY- ZINCALUME® STEEL

ZINCALUME® steel for GUTTERS AND DOWNPIPES IN RESIDENTIAL APPLICATIONS  
WARRANTY TO PERFORATION OF GUTTERS AND DOWNPIPES

BlueScope Steel Limited ABN 16 000 011 058 (hereinafter called "BlueScope Steel"), warrants that the ZINCALUME® steel supplied to ROLLFORMER for the subsequent manufacture of EAVE GUTTER AND DOWNPIPE (hereafter referred to as "the product"), is manufactured from prime material and will have a life prior to perforation by weathering in the natural elements of 12 years from the date of installation, being DATE at PROJECT-STREET ADDRESS, CITY STATE.

### Warranty is subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The product is manufactured from ZINCALUME® steel and is used in residential buildings within Australia.
2. The product has an official ZINCALUME® steel brand.
3. The product is installed in strict accordance with, in order of preference, Technical Bulletin TB-15 "Selection and use of Steel Gutter and Downpipe Products", which is available from [www.bluescopesteel.com.au](http://www.bluescopesteel.com.au), and all applicable industry standards, Building Code of Australia (ie SAA-HB39, AS2179:1994, AS3500), current at the date of installation. Where no standard applies, the product must be installed in strict accordance with the Manufacturer's published installation guidelines current at the time of installation.
4. The product must be designed in accordance with BlueScope Steel published product attributes. Refer to the Product Data Sheet available from [www.colorbond.com](http://www.colorbond.com).
5. The product, as supplied, must not at any time come into contact or be coated with an incompatible material.
6. Areas not normally exposed to rain must be washed at least once every 6 months with fresh water.
7. The product must be maintained in accordance with BlueScope Steel's maintenance guidelines as published in Technical Bulletin TB-4 "Maintenance of COLORBOND® steel and ZINCALUME® steel" which is available from [www.bluescopesteel.com.au](http://www.bluescopesteel.com.au), and the "Guttering Maintenance" guide which is available from [www.colorbond.com](http://www.colorbond.com).
8. The application of post paint treatments or systems to the product will invalidate this warranty.
9. The product does not include box gutters.
10. Perforations partly or wholly due to the following causes are not covered by this warranty.
  - a) Defects attributed to faulty design, method of manufacture or installation of the product.
  - b) Mechanical, chemical, corrosion or other damage sustained during transport, handling, storage, erection or subsequent to erection.
  - c) Attack from chemical or other agents, fumes, liquids or solids other than direct rain or run-off falling onto the product under warranty.
  - d) Contact with soil, ash, fertilizer, moisture retaining substances, lead or copper and other dissimilar metals, chemical agents, liquid from copper flashings or copper pipes, green or wet timber or treated timber. Refer to Corrosion Technical Bulletin CTB-12 "Dissimilar Metals" and CTB-13 "Contact with Timber", which are available from [www.bluescopesteel.com.au](http://www.bluescopesteel.com.au), for further information.
  - e) Failure to remove debris and/or allow free drainage of water (including condensation) from all surfaces of the product.
  - f) Corrosion arising within the lapped areas, around fasteners or accessories, including without limitation brackets, clips, end-caps, astragals and leaf guards.
  - g) Installations subject to salt marine, severe industrial or unusually corrosive environments at any time in the future.
  - h) Accidental or intentional damage by a person or animal beyond the reasonable control of BlueScope Steel.
  - i) Earthquakes, hurricanes, tornadoes, cyclones, typhoons, gales, lightning, hail, fires, flood and other similarly extreme "acts of God".

Subject to statutory obligations, under this Warranty, BlueScope Steel's liability will be limited to BlueScope Steel's choice of one of the following options:

- (i) providing the same material in a quantity sufficient to replace the defective product;
- (ii) providing the equivalent material in a quantity sufficient to replace the defective product;
- (iii) the cost of repairing the defective product.

### BlueScope Steel shall not be liable for:

- (a) labour costs associated with the removal or repair of the defective product, or installation of the replacement product;
- (b) injury to persons, damage to property, loss of income, profit or business, or any other indirect loss arising from or caused in any way by the defective product.

BlueScope Steel extends this warranty solely to the manufacturer.

BlueScope Steel reserve the right to inspect a building prior to issuing of the warranty and/or to inspect and conduct tests as necessary at any time after a claim is made under this warranty.

This warranty is given in lieu of all other considerations or warranties expressed or implied except to the extent that any statute applicable to this contract prevents the exclusion restrictions or modification of such conditions or warranties.
