ROOFING WARRANTY- ZINCALUME® STEEL

ZINCALUME® zinc/aluminium alloy coated steel
WARRANTY TO PERFORATION OF ZINCALUME® steel ROOF SHEETS

BlueScope Steel Limited ABN 16 000 011 058 (hereinafter called "BlueScope Steel"), warrants that the ZINCALUME® steel supplied to ROLLFORMER to be fabricated into PROFILE is manufactured from prime material and will have a life prior to perforation by weathering in the natural elements of PERIOD years from the date of installation, being DATE at PROJECT-STREET ADDRESS, CITY STATE

Warranty is subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The product has an official ZINCALUME® steel brand.
2. The product must be designed in accordance with BlueScope Steel published product attributes (refer to the Product Data Sheet available from www.zincalume.com).
3. The product is installed in strict accordance with, in order of preference, all relevant Technical Bulletins and Corrosion Technical Bulletins which are available from www.bluescopesteel.com.au, and all applicable industry standards, Building Code of Australia (ie. SAA-HB39, AS1562.1, AS/NZS2179.1, AS3566, AS3740, AS/NZS4600) current at the date of installation. Where no standard applies, the product must be installed in strict accordance with the Manufacturer's published installation guidelines current at the time of installation.
4. All flashings, fasteners and components fixed to or used with the product must be manufactured from materials approved by BlueScope Steel. Refer to Corrosion Technical Bulletin CTB-12 "Dissimilar Metals" and Technical Bulletin TB-16 "Fasteners for Roofing and Walling Product – Selection Guide" for further information.
5. The BlueScope Steel metallic coating, as supplied, must not be scratched, abraded, or damaged in any way, or come in contact with/or coated with an incompatible material.
6. Sheltered or areas unwashed by rain exposure must be washed down with fresh water on a regular 6 monthly basis in accordance with BlueScope Steel recommendations.
7. The product must be maintained in accordance with BlueScope Steel's maintenance guidelines as published in Technical Bulletin TB-4 "Maintenance of COLORBOND® steel and ZINCALUME® steel".
8. The application of post paint treatments or systems to the product will invalidate this warranty.
9. Perforations partly or wholly due to the following causes are not covered by this warranty:
 - a) Defects attributed to faulty design, method of manufacture or installation of the product
 - b) Mechanical, chemical, corrosion or other damage (accidental or intentional) sustained during transport, handling, storage, erection or subsequent to erection.
 - c) Attack from chemical agents, fumes, liquids or solids other than direct rain falling onto the product under warranty.
 - d) Contact with soils, ashes, fertilizers or other moisture retaining substances, lead or copper and other dissimilar metals, chemical agents, liquid from copper flashings and pipes, green or wet timber or treated timber. Refer to Corrosion Technical Bulletin CTB-12 "Dissimilar Metals" and CTB-13 "Contact with Timber".
 - e) Failure to install, use and maintain the product in accordance with BlueScope Steel's guidelines and applicable industry standards.
 - f) Failure to remove debris and/or failure to provide free drainage of water including internal condensation from all surfaces of the product.
 - g) Failure to replace corroded fasteners.
 - h) Corrosion arising within the lapped areas of end-lapped sheets.
 - i) Installations subject to unusually corrosive environments at any time in the future.
 - j) Storm and tempest or any other "acts of God".

Subject to statutory obligations, under this Warranty, BlueScope Steel's liability will be limited to BlueScope Steel's choice of one of the following options:

- i) providing the same material in a quantity sufficient to replace the defective product;
- ii) providing the equivalent material in a quantity sufficient to replace the defective product; or
- iii) the cost of repairing the defective product.

BlueScope Steel shall not be liable for:

- a) labour costs associated with the removal or repair of the defective product or installation of the replacement product;
- b) injury to persons, damage to property, loss of income, profit or business or any other indirect loss arising from or caused in any way by the defective product.

BlueScope Steel extends this warranty solely to the manufacturer.

BlueScope Steel reserve the right to inspect a building prior to issuing of the warranty and/or to inspect and conduct tests as necessary at any time after a claim is made under this warranty.

This warranty is given in lieu of all other considerations or warranties expressed or implied except to the extent that any statute applicable to this contract prevents the exclusion restrictions or modification of such conditions or warranties.
